

## AUTHOR GUIDELINES FOR IGARSS 2023 ABSTRACT

The abstract should contain minimum of 500 to maximum of 1000 words and may include 1-2 figures and graphs. References should be in second page and doesn't have page limit. All manuscripts must be in English and printed in black ink. Font type of Times-Roman is encouraged. Use a font that is no smaller than ten-point type throughout the paper, including figure captions.

The evaluation criteria for the abstracts are:

- Topic relevance
- Originality of the content
- Methodology / Research design
- Evaluation of results and derived conclusion
- References to previous work
- Correct English usage

Figures and graphs must appear within the designated margins. Caption and number every illustration. All illustrations should be clear when printed on a black-only printer. Color may be used.

Since there are many ways, often incompatible, of including images (e.g., with experimental results) in a LaTeX document, below is an example of how to do this.
